While reclaiming I hit a natural gas line 40 feet east of the junction of Jasmin lane and Sheridan lake Rd. I had my milling drum at a depth of 6.5 inches below the surface of the asphalt. Which was the agreed depth as which to run depending on the depth of the asphalt. The gas line was marked with yellow paint markers. The gas line was not potholed so there was no way of knowing the gas line wasn't deeper under the ground. After hitting the gas line the gas lite on fire underneath and behind the machine. I stopped right away and called 911 at the same time 811 was called by the prime contractor. Traffic was stopped from entering the scene to avoid further incidents from occurring. Due to the incident I was delayed for three and a half hours till the gas line was shut off and considered safe to resume work.
